BANK JULIUS BAER EUROPE LAUNCHES ITS PSD2 DEVELOPER PORTAL

Dear Third Party Providers,

On Wednesday, 13 March, Bank Julius Baer Europe S.A. has launched its Developer Portal, designed to allow third party providers to collect client payment data, as required by the Payment Services Directive 2 (PSD2).

The PSD2 has the objective to increase competition, innovation and transparency across the European Union, while improving the security of internet payments and account access. The Developer Portal will help the bank to comply with the requirements of the regulation.

This secure Sandbox environment will give access to selected, simulated application programming interfaces (APIs) with dummy data from payment accounts in scope of PSD2, under the Berlin Group standards.

In this testing facility, developers will have access to technical documentation and can test for Account Information Services (AIS).

The PSD2 Developer Portal marks a milestone in the path of digitalization, innovation and increased competitiveness on payment services.

This compliance effort is opening a new range of opportunities, which continues the Bank Julius Baer's strategy of adaptation to market evolution and its challenges.
